A few individuals of our church family are in need of transportation to and from our church on Sunday mornings. If you would like to assist these elderly individuals, please contact Pastor Dave by July.

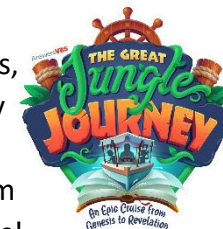
There is an Elder's meeting Tuesday, June 18<sup>th</sup> at 6:00pm.
